

#### Overview

Session II: Dr. Abdul Aleem analyzed the poetry of Urdu poet Nazeer Akbarabadi, demonstrating how his writings inspired cultural unity and national spirit.

Session III: Dr. Archana Mishra, Assistant Professor, Babasaheb Ambedkar University, highlighted national consciousness in folk poetry, illustrating the aspirations of common people through the works of Bhartendu Harishchandra and others.




